About This Week's Game

Samford will travel to Elon, N.C., to take on the 21st-ranked Elon Phoenix in a Southern Conference game Saturday afternoon.

Samford enters the game with a record of 2-2 overall and 0-1 in SoCon play after a 35-17 loss to top-ranked Appalachian State last Saturday.

Elon is currently 1-3 overall and 0-1 in league play. The Phoenix is coming off a 38-21 loss at 24th-ranked Georgia Southern.

Samford On The Road

Samford has six road games on the 2010 schedule, and the Bulldogs currently have a record of 1-1 in road games after opening the season with a 59-6 loss at 20th-ranked Florida State and then winning at Northwestern State by a score of 19-7.

Last season, Samford posted a record of 1-4 in road games. In threeplus seasons under head coach Pat Sullivan, Samford has a record of 6-11 in games played away from Seibert Stadium.

Series Notes: Samford vs. Elon

Samford and Elon are meeting for the ninth time, with Elon holding a 6-2 advantage in the series . . . the first meeting in the series came in 1973, a 33-10 Elon win at Seibert Stadium . . . the teams met each season from 1997 to 2001, with Elon winning three of those five contests . . . Elon has won both of the meetings since Samford joined the Southern Conference in 2008 . . . Samford's last win in the series came in 2001, with the Bulldogs winning, 43-36 at Seibert Stadium . . . Samford has never won at Elon . . . the average score in the series has been 33-22, Elon.

Samford In Southern Conference Games

Now in its third season as a member of the SoCon, Samford has a record of 7-10 in league games. Samford has an all-time record of 31-48-3 against the current members of the Southern Conference.

Samford has a 2-6 all-time record against this week's opponent, Elon. Samford's record against the rest of the SoCon is: Appalachian State (1-4), Chattanooga (9-23-3), The Citadel (1-2), Furman (5-7), Georgia Southern (2-3), Western Carolina (6-1) and Wofford (5-2).

Samford Against North Carolina Teams

Samford has an all-time record of 19-16 against teams from the state of North Carolina, including a 2-6 record against this week's opponent, Elon.

Samford has also played the following North Carolina schools: Appalachian State (1-4), Catawba (1-0), East Carolina (0-2), Fayetteville State (1-0), Gardner-Webb (4-2), Guilford College (3-0), Western Carolina (6-1) and Wingate (1-1).

Saturday's game at Elon is the second of three games Samford will play this season against a North Carolina team. Samford also has a game at Western Carolina on Oct. 9.

SouthernPigskin.com Honors Pope

SouthernPigskin.com named Samford freshman wide receiver **Kelsey Pope** its Southern Conference Special Teams Player of the Week for his performance in Saturday's SoCon opener against top-ranked Appalachian State.

In the game, Pope returned four kickoffs for 128 yards (32.0 ypr.). He had a long return of 66 yards in the game.

Leading The SoCon

As a team, Samford currently leads the Southern Conference in kickoff return average, with an average of 29.2 yards per return.

Individually for the Bulldogs, senior linebacker **Bryce Smith** leads the league in tackles, averaging 11.5 per game. **Kelsey Pope** leads the league in kickoff return average at 31.9 yards per return.

Among National Leaders

Samford currently ranks third in the nation in kickoff return average. **Bryce Smith** is tied for the national lead in solo tackles per game, and he ranks 10th in the country in total tackles per game. **Kelsey Pope** is tied for fifth in the nation in kickoff return average, while **Fabian Truss** ranks 10th in the nation in the same category.

Scoring Points

Samford has scored in its last 103-consecutive games. The last time Samford was shut out in a football game was on Nov. 9, 2000, a 29-0 loss at Tennessee Tech

Samford In October Games

Samford has an all-time record of 167-181-23 in games played in the month of October. This season, the Bulldogs have four games scheduled for October, with Saturday's game being the first of those contests.

Last season, Samford posted a record of 1-3 in the 10th month.

Samford Against Ranked Opponents

Saturday's game against 21st-ranked Elon is Samford's second-consecutive game against a ranked opponent. The Bulldogs have not defeated a ranked opponent since Oct. 8, 1994, when the Bulldogs upset sixth-ranked UCF, 36-35 at Seibert Stadium.

Senior running back **Chris Evans** has been named to the preseason watch list for the Walter Payton Ward by the Sports Network and senior linebacker **Bryce Smith** was named to the watch list for the Buck Buchanan Award, also given by the Sports Network. The Payton Award goes to the top player in the Division I-Football Championship Subdivision, while the Buchanan Award is given to the top defensive player in Division I-FCS.

Senior linebacker **Bryce Smith** has been named the fifth recipient of the Charles Williams Memorial Jersey. The jersey, the No. 5, is given each year to one of the Samford seniors. The jersey honors former Samford player Charles Williams, who died in a car accident on May 23, 2003.

Evans Closing In On 4,000-Yard Mark

Senior running back **Chris Evans**, who is already Samford's all-time leading rusher, is closing in on the 4,000-yard mark for his career. Evans has rushed for 3,773 yards in his Samford career. He has rushed for over 1,000 yards in each of his three seasons and is the only player in Samford history to rush for over 1,000 yards

SoCon Preseason Awards

Samford senior linebacker Bryce Smith was named the Southern Conference's preseason Defensive Player of the Year when the league's head coaches released their preseason awards recently. Smith was joined on the first team All-Conference team by Chris Evans, Thomas Gray and Bob Hooper. Samford's second team representatives were Riley Hawkins, John Michael Clay and Richie Fordham

Freshmen Coming Up Big

Samford has three freshmen who have already made a major impact on the team this season. Wide receivers **Quin Roberson** and **Kelsey Pope** are the team's top two receivers and Pope is one of the top kick return men in the nation. Running back **Fabian Truss** is second on the team in rushing and is also among the SoCon and national leaders in kick returns.

Head Coach Pat Sullivan



Pat Sullivan was hired as Samford's 35th head football coach on Dec. 1, 2006.

In just three seasons as head coach, Sullivan has already had a major impact on the program.

In 2008, Sullivan led Samford to its first winning season since 2003 with a 6-5 overall record. The Bull-dogs also finished tied for fourth in its first season in the Southern Conference after being picked to finish last in all of the league's preseson polls.

Following the 2008 season, five Samford players were named to the SoCon's All-Conference teams, including running back Chris Evans, who became Samford's first running back to rush for more than 1,000 yards in back-to-back seasons. Freshman quarterback Dustin Taliaferro was also named the 2008 SoCon Freshman of the Year.

After the 2009 season, five Samford players were named to the SoCon's All-Conference team, and three more Bulldogs were named to the league's All-Freshman team.

In his first season as Samford's head coach the program saw major improvements. The Bulldogs improved in nearly every offensive category from the 2006 season.

"It's a pleasure to come to work every day to serve with people like Pat Sullivan," Director of Athletics Bob Roller said. "Pat and his staff have assembled a football team that entered the highly-competitive Southern Conference and backed down from no one. He has done it absolutely the right way in every respect."

In addition to the successes on the field and in recruiting, Sullivan has made a major impact on the school's fundraising efforts. The Cooney Family Field House, which is named for Birmingham business executive and Samford graduate Gary Cooney was opened prior to the 2009 season in the south end zone of Seibert Stadium. The field house was funded completely from private donations.

Sullivan, the winner of the 1971 Heisman Trophy as a quarterback at Auburn University, is the 35th head football coach in Samford history. He came to Samford after serving on the coaching staff at the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) since 1999.

"In every respect, Pat exemplifies the qualities that are important to Samford," Samford President Dr. Andrew Westmoreland said. "People are drawn to the strength of his character, his commitment to his student-athletes, his emphasis on performance in the classroom as well as on the field and his faith. In addition, his teams win. What more could we ask?"

While at UAB, Sullivan worked with the team's quarterbacks and was the offensive coordinator from 1999-2005. He served as the assistant head coach and running backs coach in 2006. He recruited and coached Darrell Hackney, the all-time leading passer in UAB history, and the third-leading passer in Conference USA history.

During Sullivan's time at UAB, the Blazers posted an overall record of 43-49, and the 2004 team earned the program's first bowl bid to the Sheraton Hawaii Bowl. Sullivan also has experience as a head coach at the Division I-FBS level, as he served as the head coach at TCU from 1992-97. He helped lead the Horned Frogs to back-to-back winning seasons for the first time in 42 years with records of 7-5 in 1994 and 6-5 in 1995. His 1994 team also earned a berth in the Independence Bowl, the school's first bowl bid in 10 years.

Sullivan was named the 1994 Southwest Conference Coach of the Year. He also earned the Top Newcomer Award from American Football Quarterly in 1995 after taking the program from a 2-8-1 record in 1992 to the consecutive winning seasons in 1994 and 1995. His six-year record at TCU was 24-42-1.

Before becoming head coach at TCU, Sullivan spent six seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, Auburn University. Sullivan coached the quarterbacks at Auburn, coaching three of the top passers in the program's history (Jeff Burger, Reggie Slack and Stan White). Sullivan, working under head coach Pat Dye, helped Auburn win three Southeastern Conference championships (1987, '88, '89) and post an overall record of 52-16-3.

Sullivan, a 1972 graduate of Auburn, was a three-year starter at quarterback for the Tigers (1969-71). In addition to winning the Heisman Trophy, he was named an All-American and the SEC Player of the Year in 1970 and 1971. He helped lead Auburn to three post-season bowl appearances, and was named the MVP of the 1970 Gator Bowl and the 1971 Sugar Bowl.

Following his senior season, Sullivan was named the MVP of the 1972 Senior Bowl, and he played in the College All-Star Classic, taking on the Super Bowl champion Dallas Cowboys.

Sullivan played professional football for five seasons with the Atlanta Falcons, Washington Redskins and San Francisco 49ers.

Sullivan is a member of the Alabama Sports Hall of Fame, the National Football Foundation Hall of Fame and the College Football Hall of Fame.

Sullivan has previous ties to Samford as his father, Jerry, played football at Samford (then Howard College) in 1949 and 1950. One of the elder Sullivan's teammates was Bobby Bowden.

Sullivan and his wife, Jean, have three children, daughter Kim, and twins Kelly and Patrick. The couple also has eight grand-children, Alex, Jay, Mallory, Joseph, Taylor, Lucy, John Michael and Claire.

No. 20 Florida State 59, Samford 6 Sept. 4, 2010

Bobby Bowden Field at Doak Campbell Stadium, 68,438

TALLAHASSEE, Fla.—The 20th-ranked Florida State football team scored 35 second-quarter points to break open the game on its way to a 59-6 win over Samford in the season-opener for both teams at Bobby Bowden Field at Doak Campbell Stadium.

The game was played in front of a crowd of 68,438, the second largest crowd ever to see a Samford team play.

For Samford offensively, junior quarterback Dustin Taliaferro completed 22-of-32 passes for 174 yards and an interception. Freshman wide receiver Quin Roberson caught 11 passes for 96 yards in his collegiate debut. Fellow freshman receiver Kelsey Pope had four catches for 51 yards, while senior receiver DeMarcus Covington caught four passes for 56 yards.

Defensively for Samford, senior linebacker Bryce Smith had nine tackles and an interception. Senior safety Thomas Broussard also had an interception to go along with his five tackles. Sophomore place-kicker Cameron Yaw was good on both of his field goal attempts, making kicks of 41 and 32 yards.

For Florida State, Christian Ponder completed 12-of-14 passes for 167 yards, four touchdowns and an interception. Backup quarterback E.J. Manuel completed 10-of-13 passes for 129 yards and an interception. Ty Jones rushed eight times for 107 yards and a touchdown, while Bert Reed caught five passes for 50 yards and a touchdown.

The Seminole defense was led by Anthony McCloud and Nigel Bradham with six tackles apiece. Mike Harris had an interception for FSU.

On Florida State's first possession of the game, the Seminoles drove deep into Samford territory. Samford's Smith, however, intercepted a Ponder pass at the six-yard line to end the threat.

NATCHITOCHES, La.—The Samford defense held Northwestern State to just 47 yards rushing and 10 first downs as the Bulldogs earned a 19-7 win over the Demons at Turpin Stadium.

Samford senior running back Chris Evans rushed 25 times for 109 yards and a touchdown. Freshman wide receiver Quin Roberson caught six passes for career-high 124 yards. Junior quarterback Dustin Taliaferro completed 14-of-22 passes for 180 yards and an interception.


